NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

The racing will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012. The principle language used will be English, though briefings will be given in Greek.

The official notice board is at Wildwind. Briefing times will be posted

2 Eligibility & Entry

Entry is open to Laser dinghies and catamarans.

Entry Fees – The entry fee is 5 Euros per person or 18 Euros per person including T-shirt and dinner.

A. Long distance racing will be held on **Thursday 30 June** starting at 1100 in the following class:

All catamaran classes will race under the ISAF small handicap rating system.

B. Racing will be held on Friday 1st July in the following classes:

i. **Laser 1 Mens, Laser Radial Womens, Laser 4.7 Youths.**

ii. **All catamaran classes will race under the ISAF small handicap rating system.**

iii. **Open Dinghy class –open to any dinghy under 6 metres; all dinghies will race under the RYA Portsmouth handicap racing system.**

Parent/Guardian Declarations

All helms and crews who are under 18 years of age must submit declarations signed by their parent or guardian.

Television and Media

Competitors automatically grant to the organising authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the events.

3 Schedule

Lasers and Catamarans

Up to 4 races will be held on Friday 1st July. It is HOPED that there will be 2 light wind races each morning, and 2 strong wind races each afternoon, one of which MAY be a Long Distance 10km race. The first start is scheduled for 11:00 am Friday 1st July Skippers Briefing at 09:45 hrs.

4 Sailing Instructions

The full written sailing instructions will be posted on the Race Notice Board and announced clearly.

5 Prizes

Trophies/Medals will be awarded to at least the first three competitors in each category.

6 Statement of Liability

Competitors are entirely responsible for their own safety, whether afloat or ashore, and nothing reduces this responsibility. It is for competitors to decide whether their boat and its helm and crew are fit to sail in the conditions that they might find. By launching or going to sea competitors confirm their boat is fit for those conditions and that they are competent to sail and compete in them.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the owners and/or competitors, nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the racing. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the event.

The provision of patrol boats does not relieve owners and competitors of their responsibilities.

7 Insurance

Boats are required to be adequately insured including insurance against third party claims – under Greek law for a minimum of 200,000 Euros.
